Per Wisconsin statues regarding administration of drugs to students changed and STM is no longer able to dispense non-prescription medication. The legislation is intended to improve the safety of administering medication to our students. Key points are as follows:

- Over-the-counter medication must be provided by a parent/guardian.
- Non-prescription medication must be sent to school in manufacturer's original packaging.
- Medications sent with student must be labeled and will be stored securely in the General Office.
- Prescription medication must be sent in a pharmacy-labeled container with the dosage needed.
- Medication may be dispensed by Linda Janick, General Office Manager only after a parent/guardian has provided written consent.
