

(1) Be sure you meet all the prerequisites for the courses you select. (2) You must choose a min. of 7.0 credits. If you would like a study hall each semester, register for 7.0 credits. You will not need to register for a study hall, it will be assigned to you. You may select a max. of 8.0 credits, but because of the combination of choices, there is no guarantee that all can be scheduled. This also means you would not have a study hall. (3) Consider taking a foreign language. Many colleges/universities want to see a min. of 2 years of the same foreign language. (4) If there is a concern about course placement, please see your teacher.
