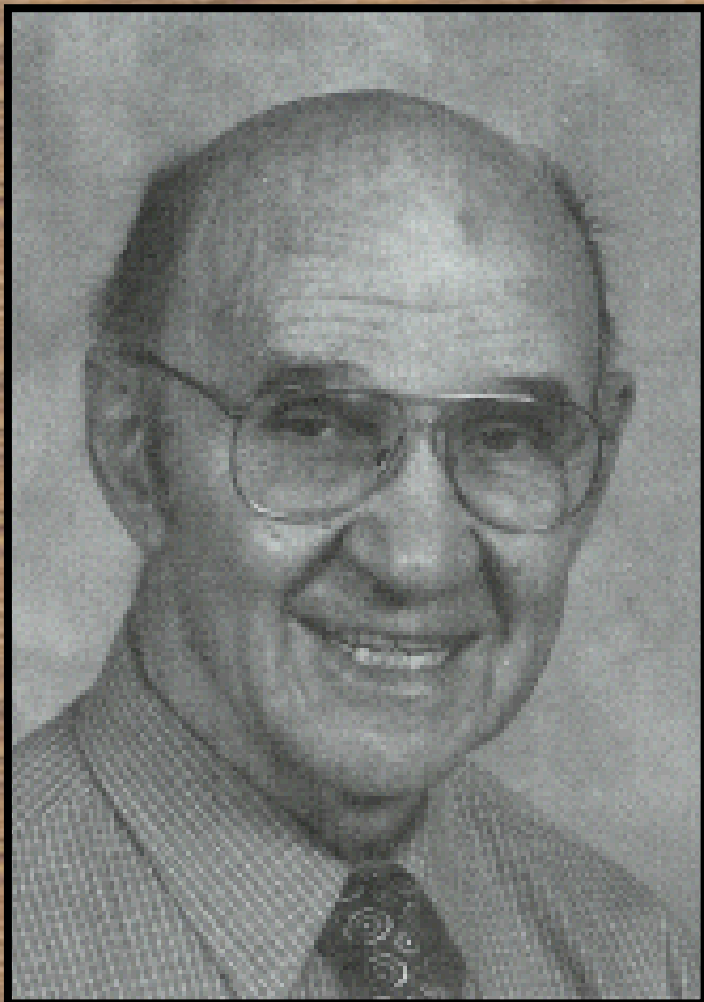

Ed Race (PN '32)

Ed Race devoted his life to helping others reach their full potential. Ed dedicated over 30 years of his life to coaching and molding youth and transforming them into productive, loving, engaged citizens. Ed coached thousands of students over the years in football, basketball, hockey, and baseball, and he won six state championships combined at Racine St. Catherine High School between 1948 and 1961.

Aside from his sport accolades, Ed received praise for his community and service work. He received the Youth Award in 1958 for his outstanding record of building admirable family men through sports, as well as a Certificate of Appreciation in 1957 by the City of Racine for his valuable leadership and training rendered to the youth of Racine. In 1985 Milwaukee Magazine selected him as one of the 85 most interesting personalities in Milwaukee.

Ed is a member of the Gesu Church where he volunteers to help the poor and assist the elderly. He and his wife, Olga, have been married for 57 years, and they have been blessed with 7 children, 9 grandchildren, and 2 great-grandchildren.
